- A few things made from wood are:

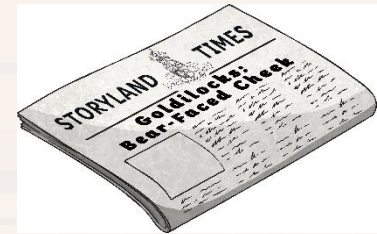
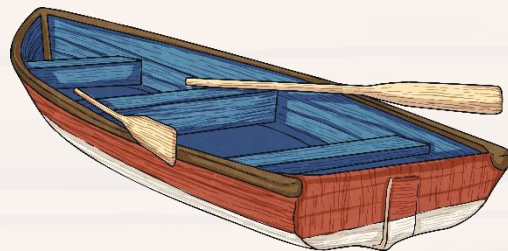

Fabric

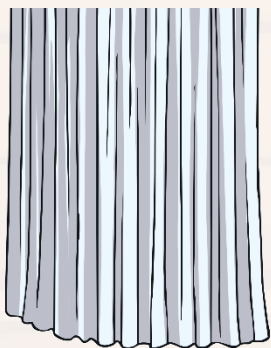
- Fabric comes from plants and animals.

Plastic

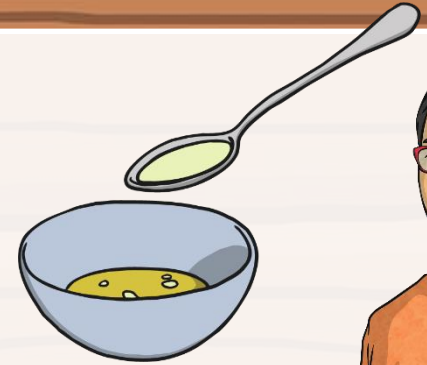
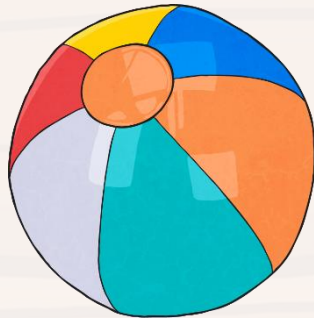
- Plastics are man-made, mostly from oil.

Metal

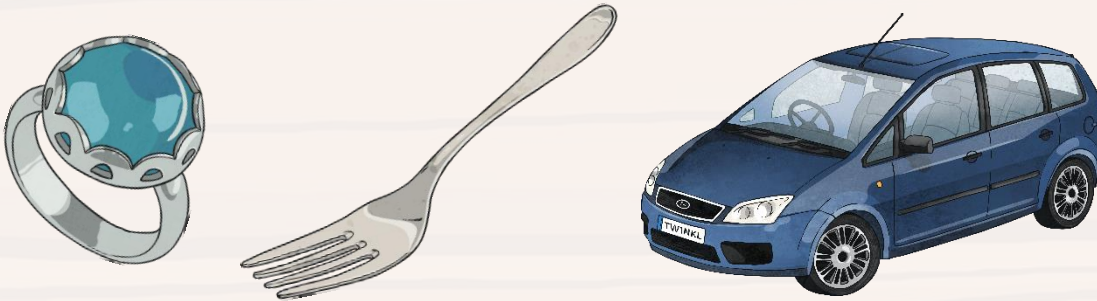
- Metals are made from rocks. The rocks are dug up and taken to a factory where they are heated and processed into metal.

jewellery

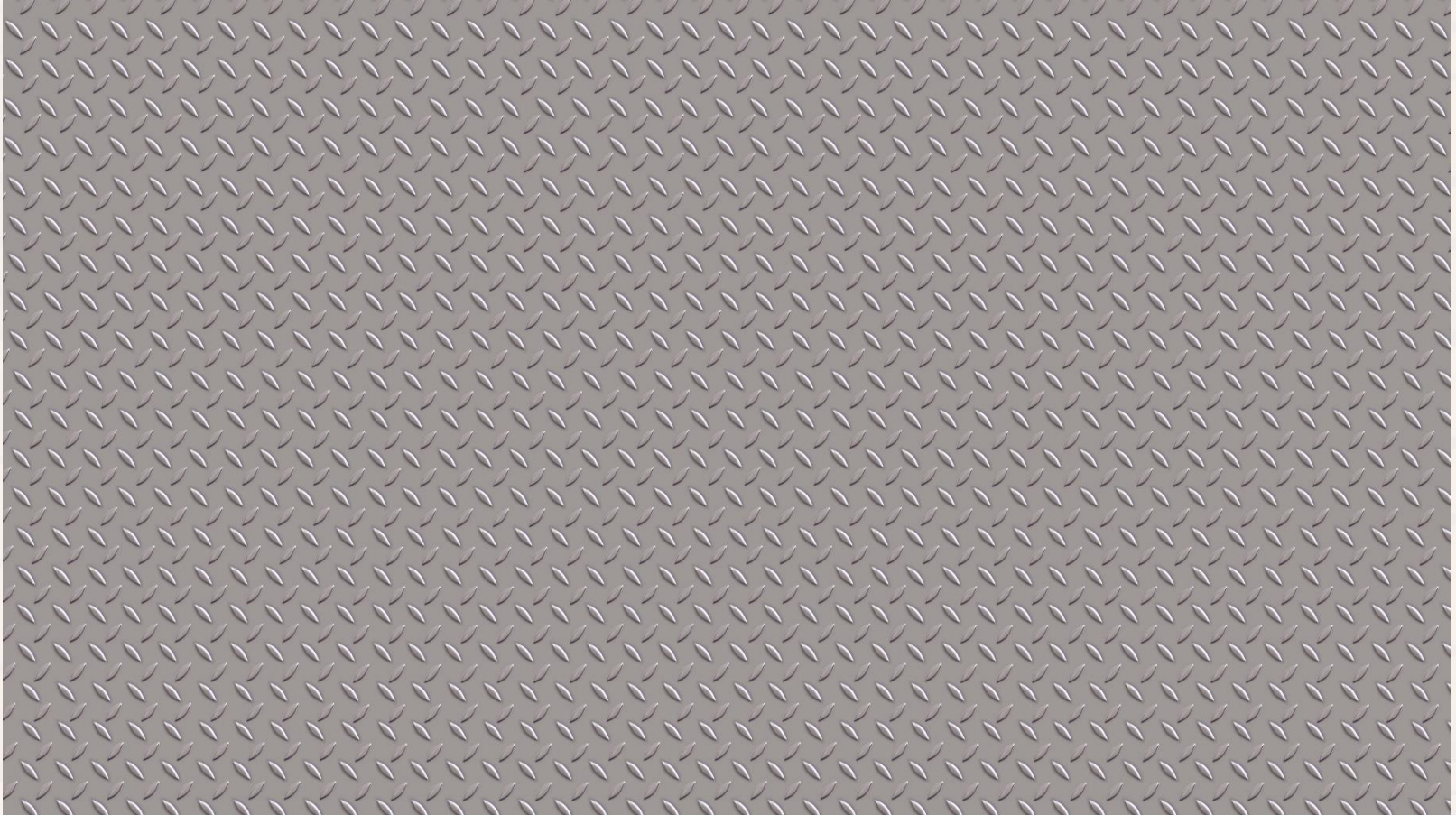

Glass

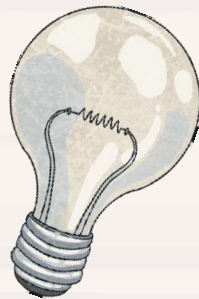
- Glass is made from very fine sand. It is heated until it melts.
