Sun



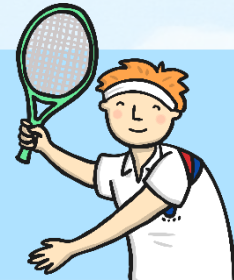

Rain



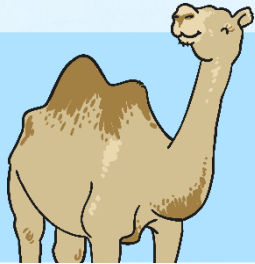

Snow

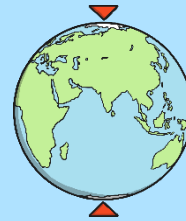
Snow is frozen rain.

Storms

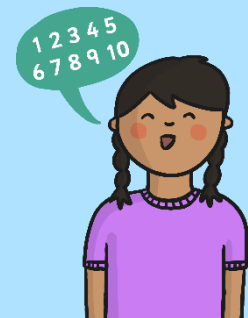

You can count how far away a storm is between lightning and thunderclap.



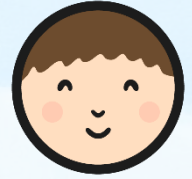
When there is a thunderstorm, there is a dark cloudy sky.

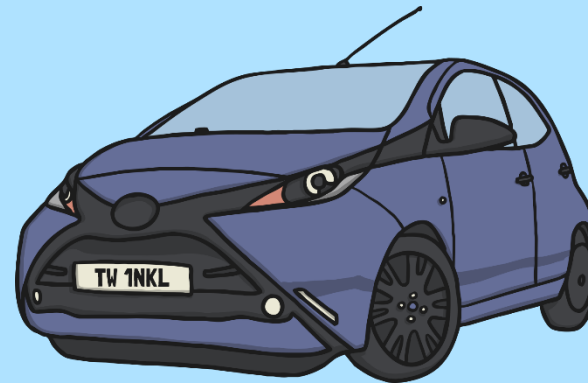
