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Homework

Homework books are sent out on a Friday and need to be back in by next Wednesday so they can be marked and new homework added.

Homework alternates between a piece of English and Maths which reinforces something we have covered in class and more open ended tasks e.g. Tell me what you know about.... Which supports learning in RE, Theme and Science.

These tasks can be presented in different ways e.g. writing, pictures, photographs, research ...

Homework

Please continue to help your child with their reading.

When your child has read to you please sign their reading diary so we know an adult has heard them read and include any relevant comments particularly if there are any difficulties. Remember to ask questions to check that they are understanding what they are reading about.

Reading books need to be in school everyday.
Children will continue to be heard read in school.

Homework

As part of their homework some children are given weekly spellings. The spellings are taken from the RWI book they are currently reading and should already be familiar to the children and contain letters and sounds they have been practising reading and writing.

In addition there are a few “red” words which don’t follow the expected pattern but are necessary for the children to know.

These will be tested in RWI lessons on a Wednesday.

R.E. Programme

Family masses are usually the first Sunday of every month.

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SATS

These are sat during the whole of May so children are expected in everyday. Please do not have your child off during this time period for anything other than illness.
