Helpful tip: Use the space bar on your laptop to pause and play the video if you need extra time. If you are using a phone/tablet, tap the screen to pause/play.



The teacher uses the educational tv show 'Number Blocks' to help the children understand number. If your child hasn't seen the show then perhaps watch some of series 1 this week. You can find the videos on BBC iplayer.



Please use your number line to 10 and number rhyme poster to help you with the numbers (you were given these in your resource packs in September)

Helpful tip: When completing the 'main lesson' task, rewind the video to when the pictures are bigger so they are easier to count.

- Monday – Lesson one – You will need number cards, counting objects and a 'ten frame' (see lesson for more detail)
- Tuesday – Lesson Two – You will need number cards, counting objects and two 'ten frames'
- Wednesday – Lesson Three - You will need number cards, counting objects and two 'ten frames'.
- Thursday – Lesson Four - You will need number cards, counting objects and two 'ten frames'. When forming the number 9 please use the school number formation rhyme "make a hoop then a line, that's the way to make a nine".
- Friday - Lesson Five - You will need number cards, counting objects and a 'ten frame'.

Oak National Academy Literacy Lessons – The Giant Turnip

Before the lesson ask the children what they think a turnip is and then a sheep dog.

Show the children the picture of the turnip and explain it is a vegetable that grows underground.

Show the picture of the sheepdog. Explain why it is called a sheep dog (it helps the farmer get his sheep back into the stable for bedtime).



- Monday – Lesson One - You will need your yellow exercise book and a teddy talk partner.
- Tuesday – Lesson Two - You will need your yellow exercise book and a teddy talk partner. Keep the story map you have drawn.
- Wednesday – Lesson Three – You will need your teddy talk partner and your story map.
- Thursday – Lesson Four – You will need your teddy talk partner and your story map.
- Friday - Lesson Five – You will need your teddy talk partner.

Draw or paint and label your favourite vegetables and help prepare and cook some for your dinner.



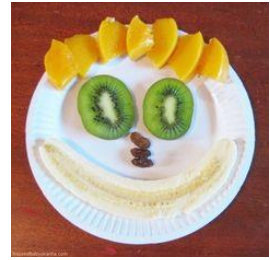
Role Play
