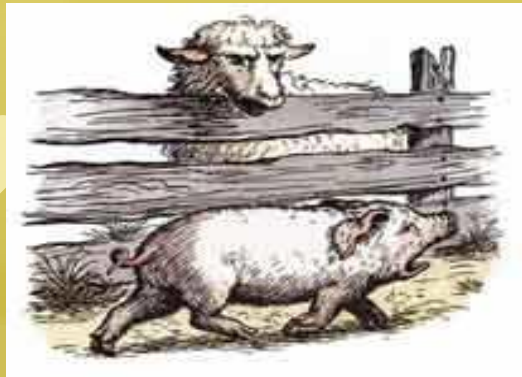

It describes a fast movement.

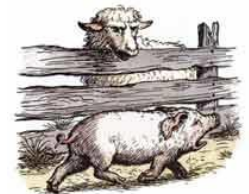

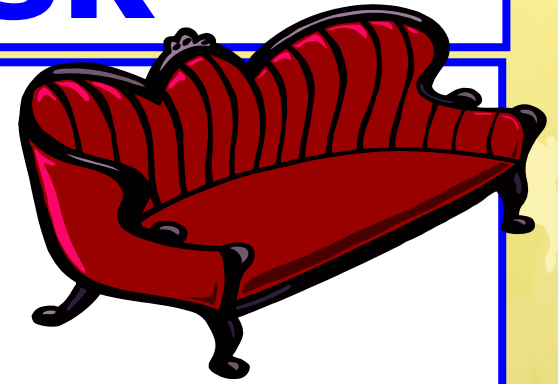

3. What promise does Charlotte make?



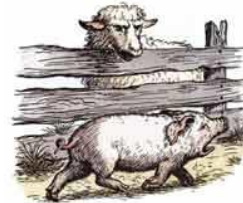
Writing Task

Generic Questions:

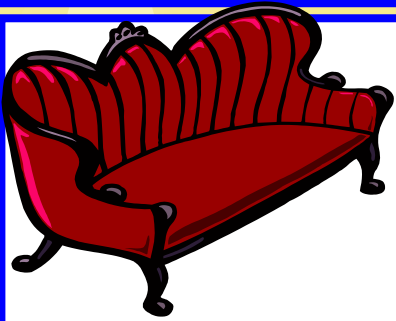
Create a list of three to five generic questions that you could ask any character in order to find out who they are.

Hot-Seating Game



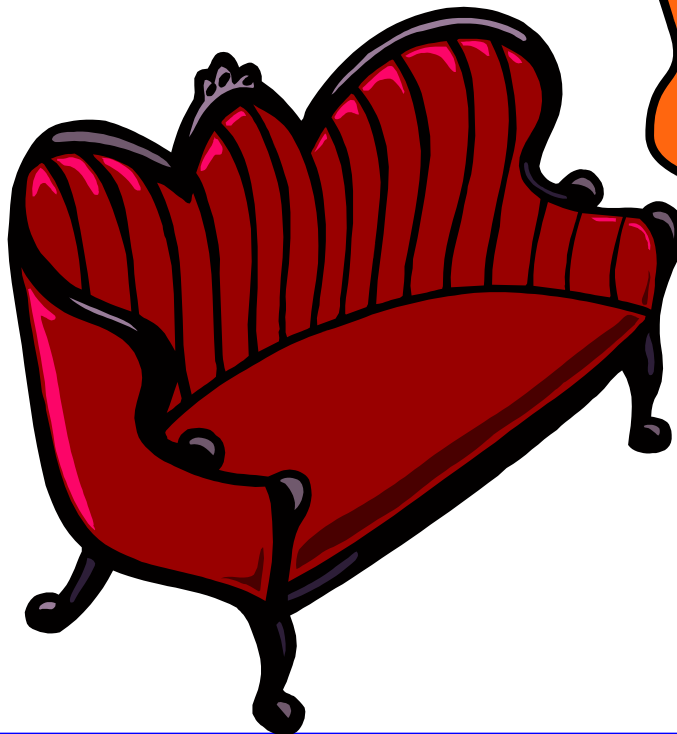
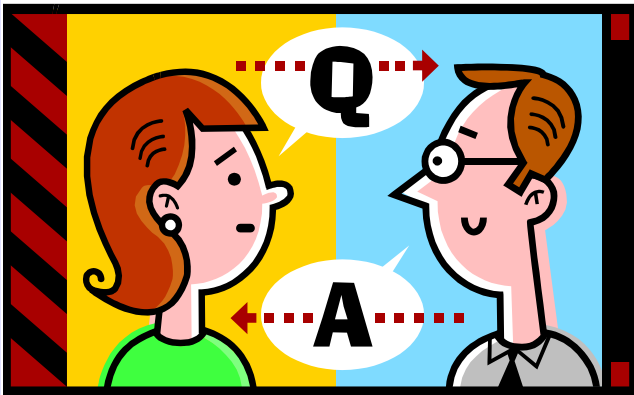
Look at your character card,

you can only answer Yes or No.

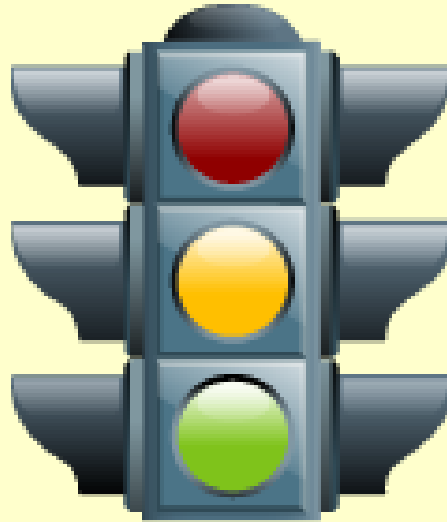
Once the group have correctly guessed which

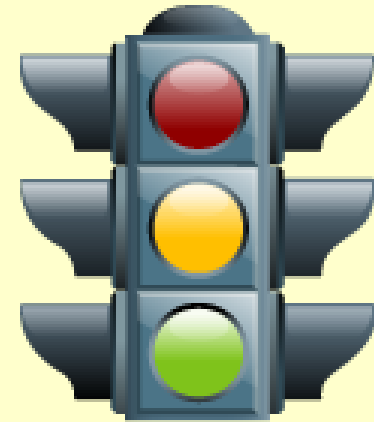
