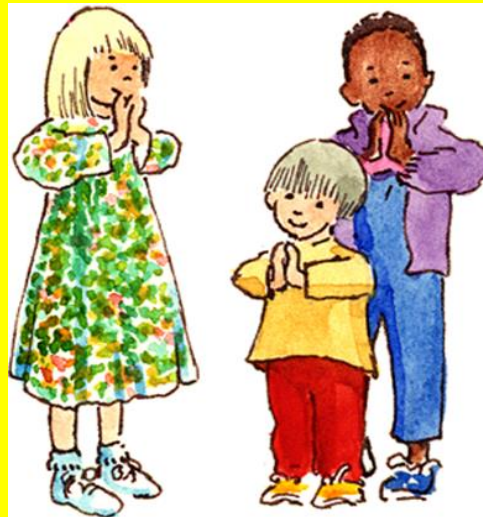

All that I do and think and say,

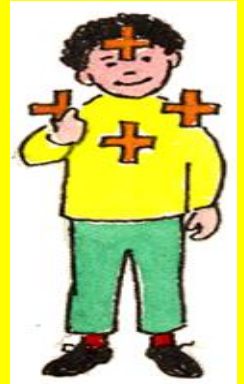
All my work and happy play,

Faith-filled & Hopeful

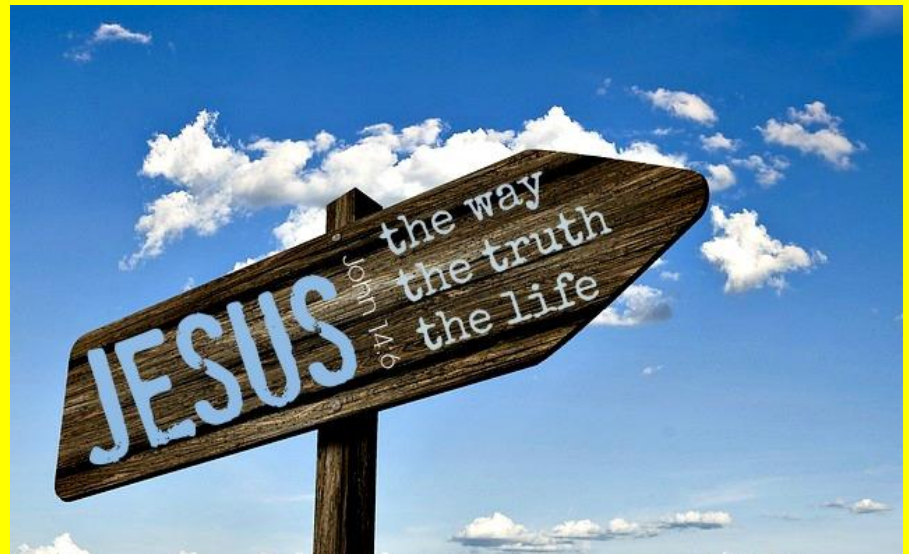
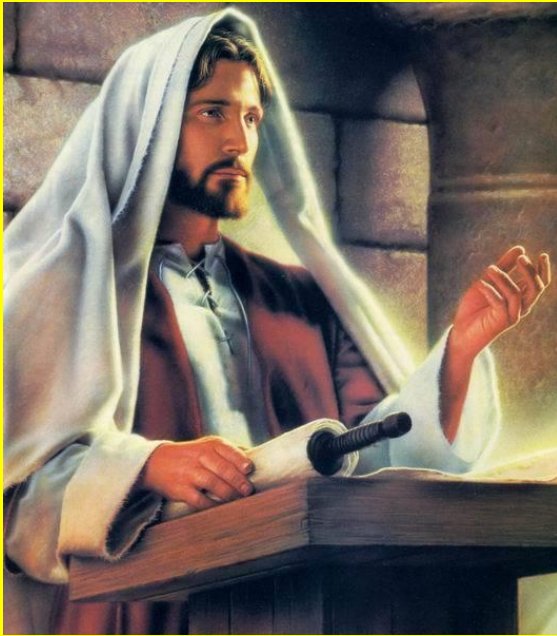

Eloquent & Truthful

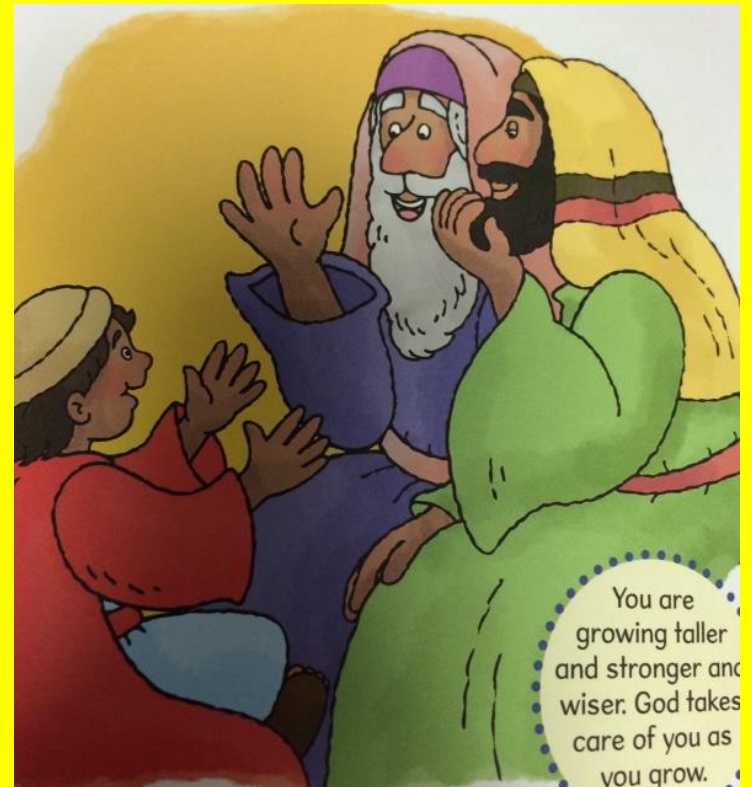
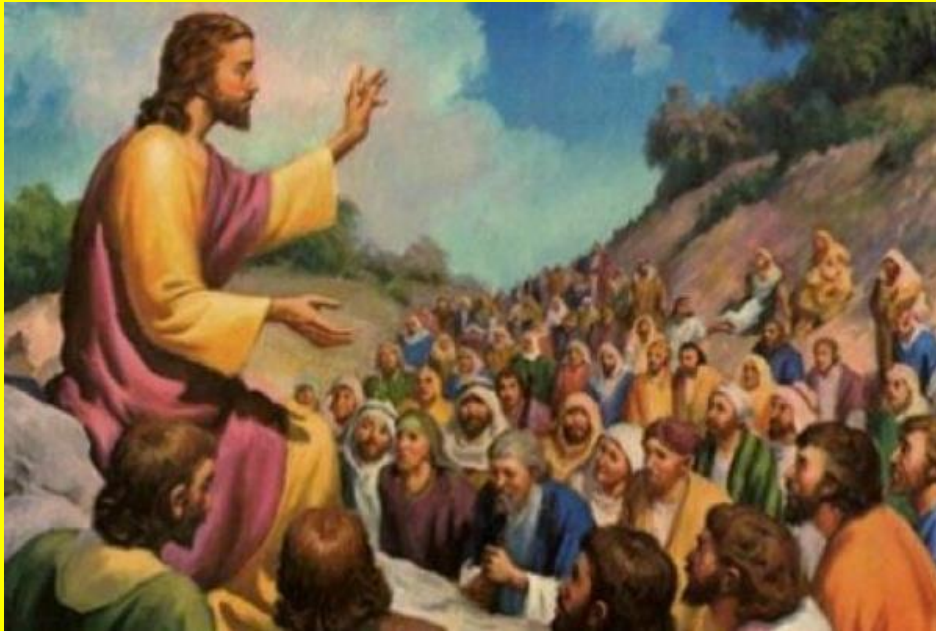
Eloquent in the way in which we speak to each other and **truthful** in our words, actions, to the Gospel and to ourselves.

At that time Jesus said, "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children."

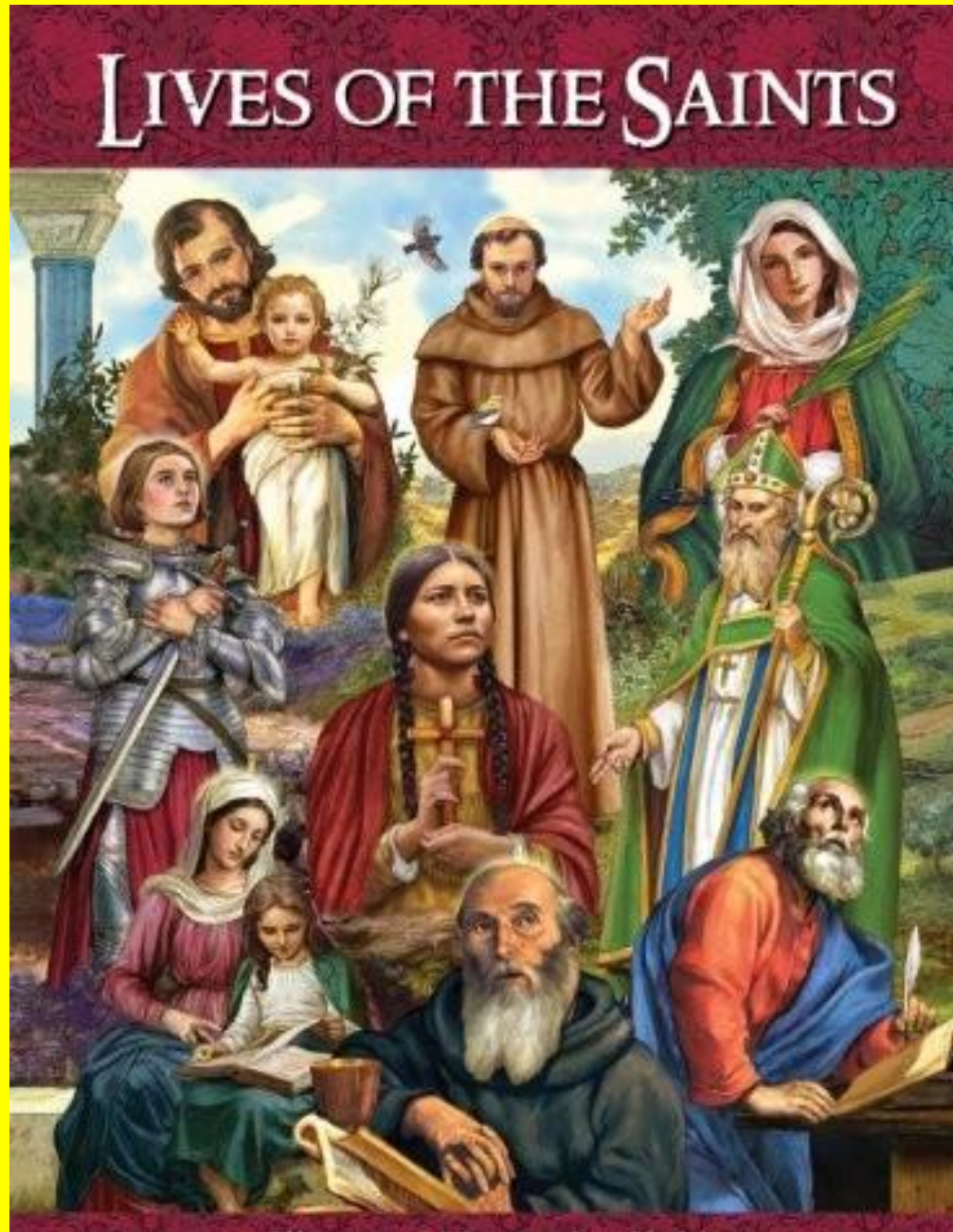


Parables
