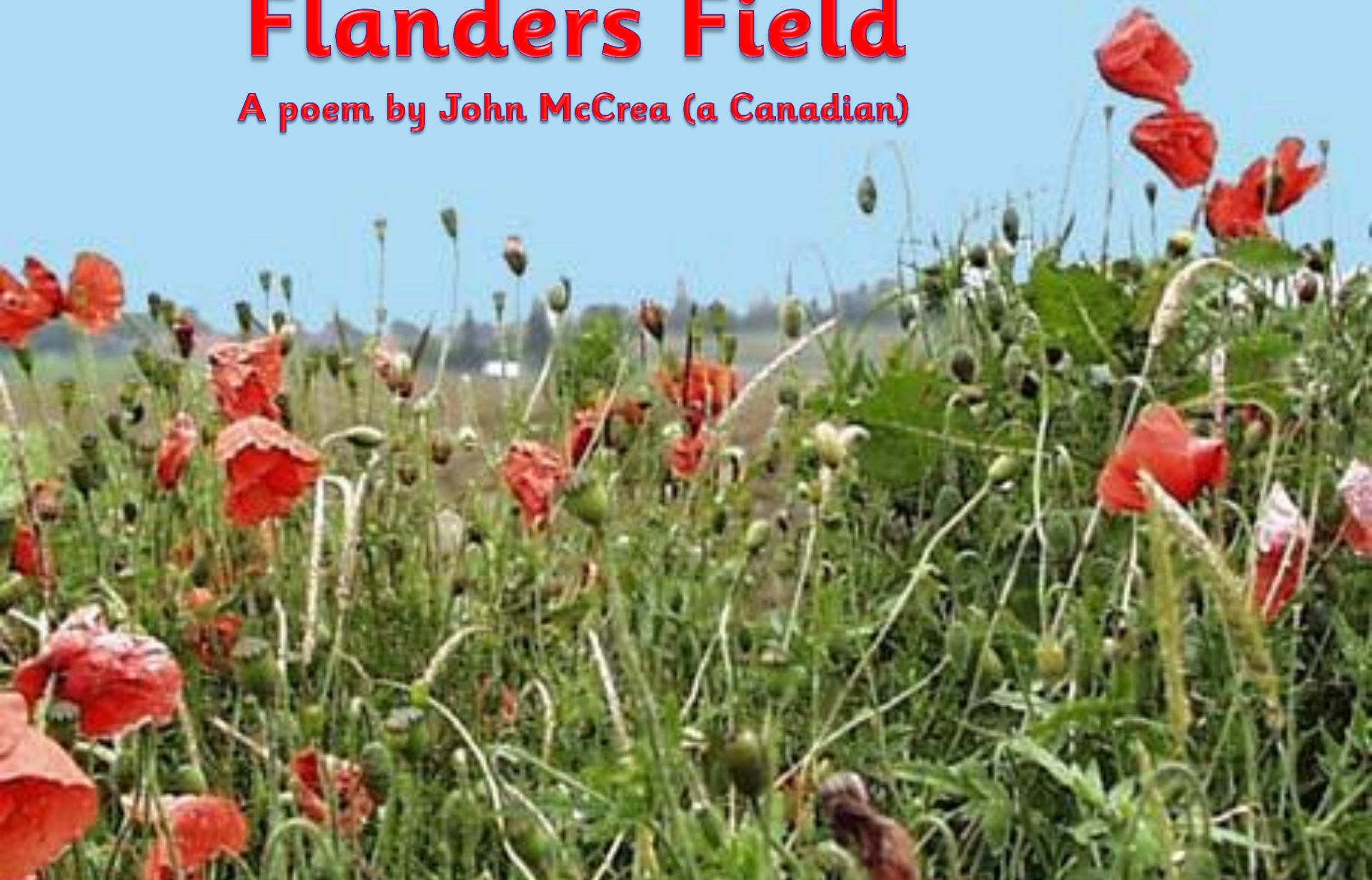

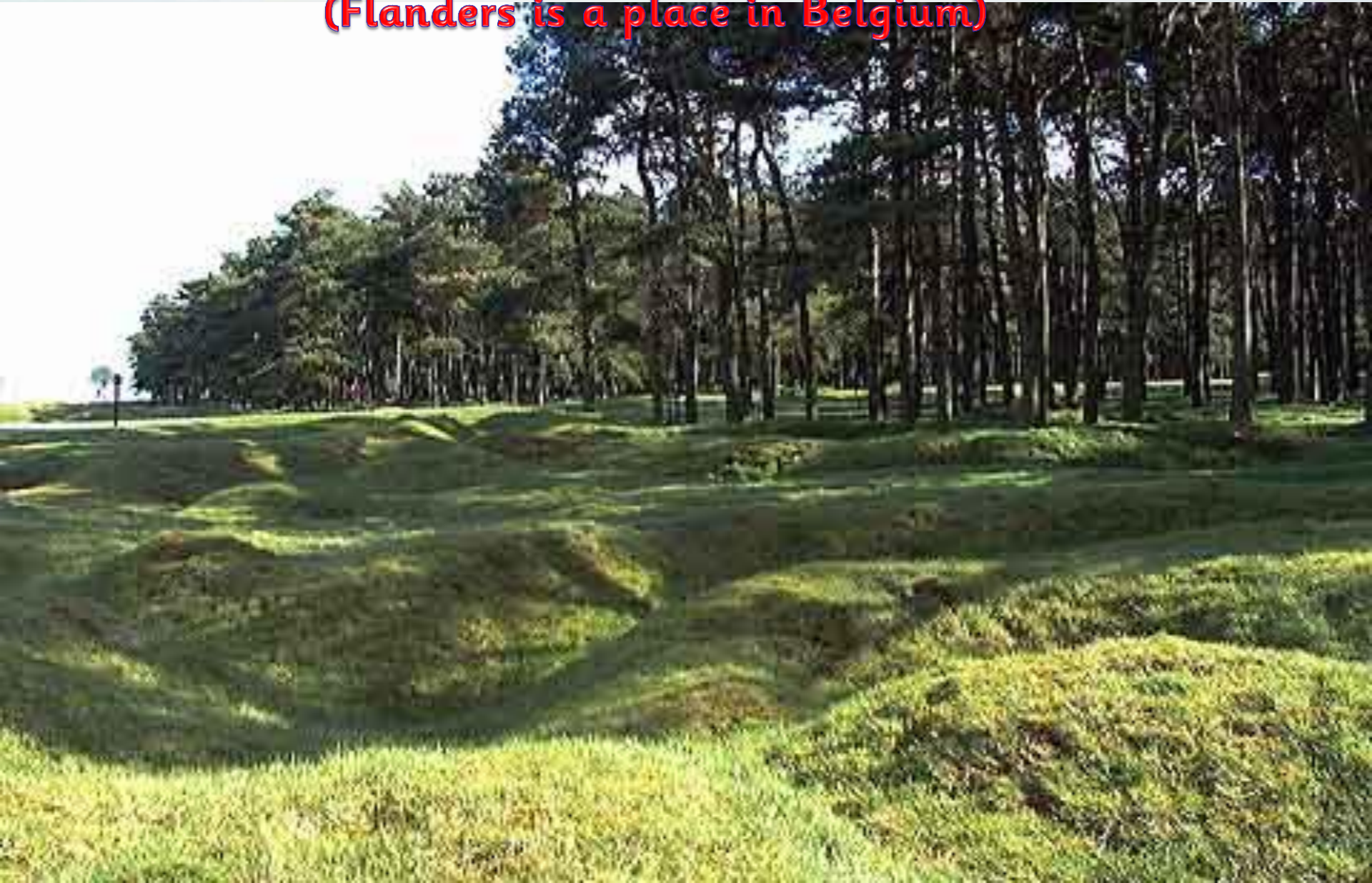
Flanders Field

still singing bravely, fly...**



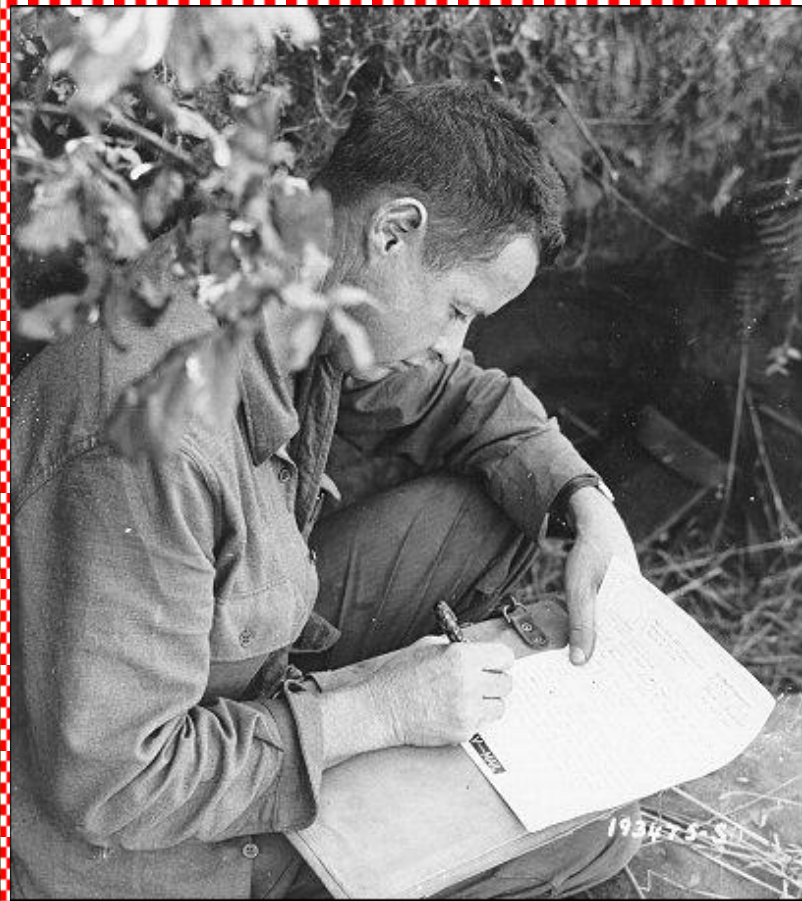
scarce heard amid the guns below ...



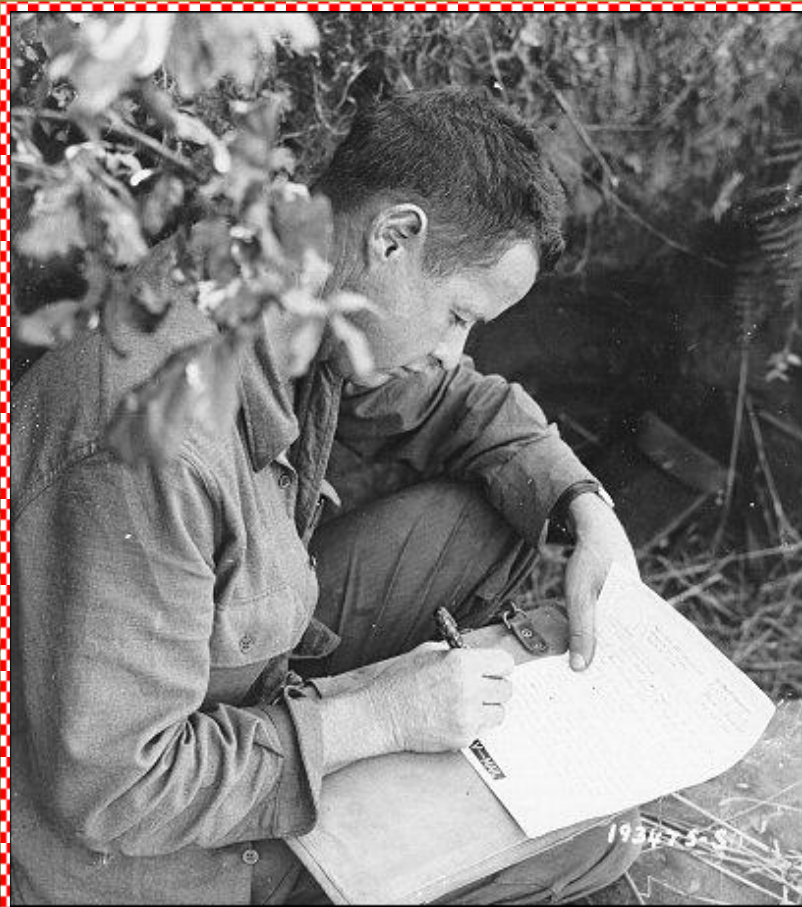

Loved**



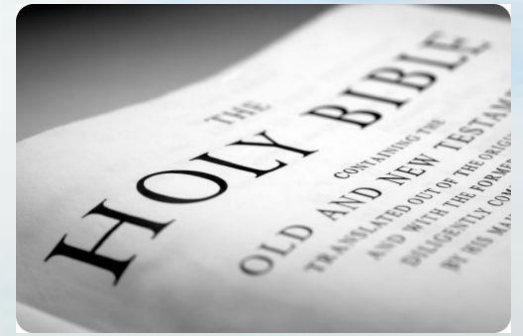
