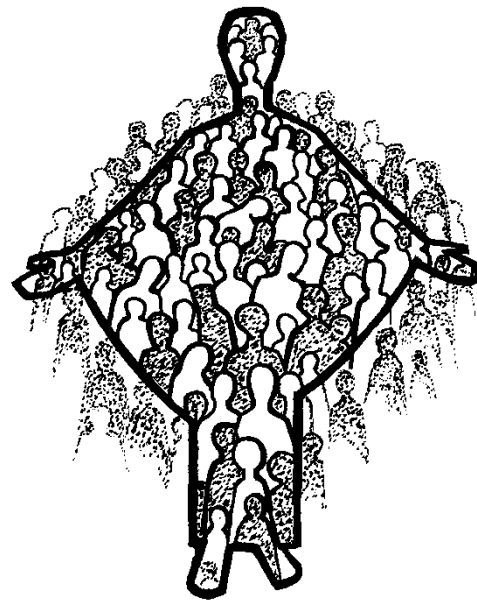

R.E. Programme

Year 6 will make their Confirmation on October 20th, 2021

We are busy studying the RE units to support the children's preparation in school. They will be assigned homework to research their chosen Saint name & produce a project; please support them in this.

Children are attending Mass in school fortnightly. Throughout the year, there will also be Sunday family Masses that you will be asked to support.

21st Century Living

Encourage children to join in a club in school or out of school.

Reduce amount of time that children are spending online across all devices.

Children who spend 2 hours a day online are at increased risk of anxiety and behavioural issues- that includes using the internet for educational purposes.

Encourage children to read each day, and before bed-time. It's also beneficial for them to listen to you read to them.

How can I help my child at home?

Homework- sent out on Friday, back by Wednesday. Children will be receiving a maths, & grammar book. Each week, children will be given allocated pages to complete for homework; images of these are to be uploaded to Seesaw. We will ask for the books to be returned to school half-termly.

Times tables practise- 10 minutes each evening using Time table Rockstars.

Reading- All children should be listened to read a couple of times a week & share books with your children- they love it!

Occasionally – children will be set a separate homework piece/project. This will be shared with the children & uploaded to Seesaw.

Reminders

- Uniform: plain stud earrings **only!** No nail varnish and long hair tied up. No trainers.
- School day begins from 8.45-9.00am & finishes at 3.15pm. Drop off & collect at the back door near to the church.
- No holidays to be booked in term time please. These will not be authorised!
