

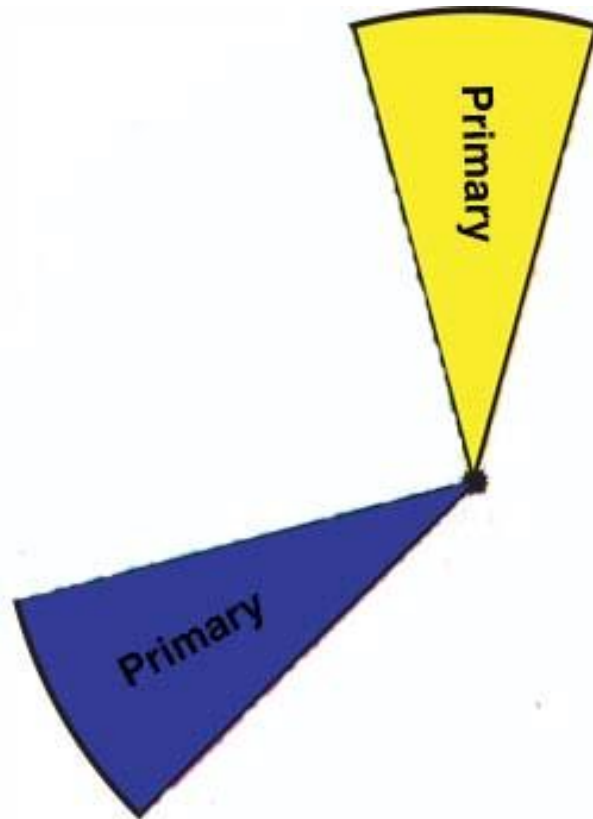

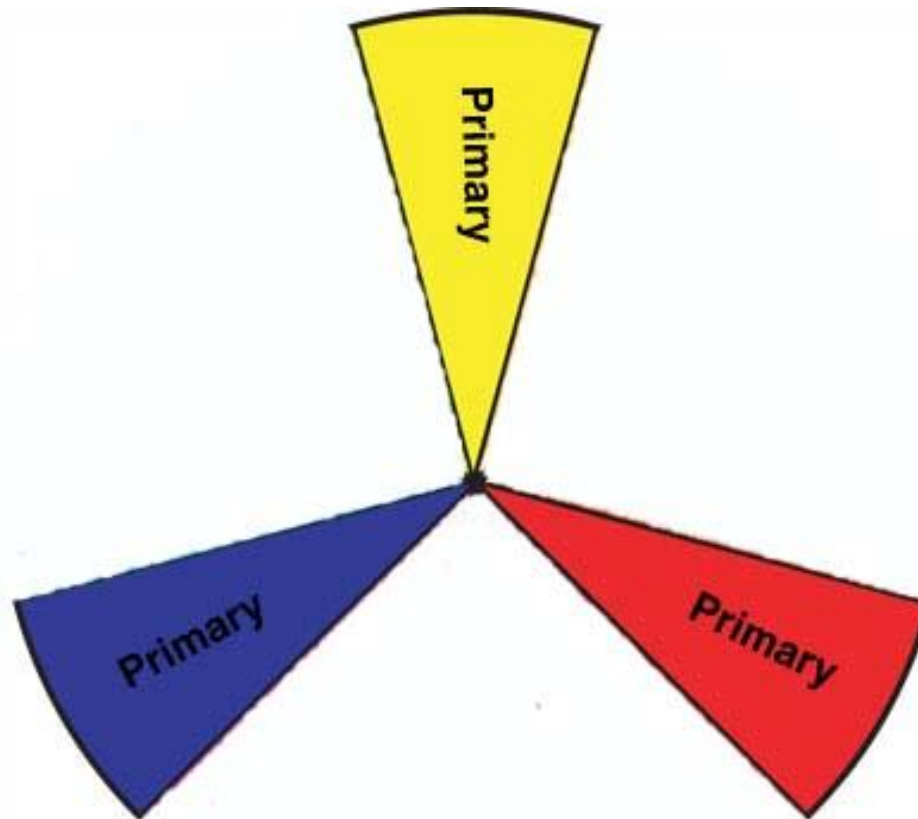

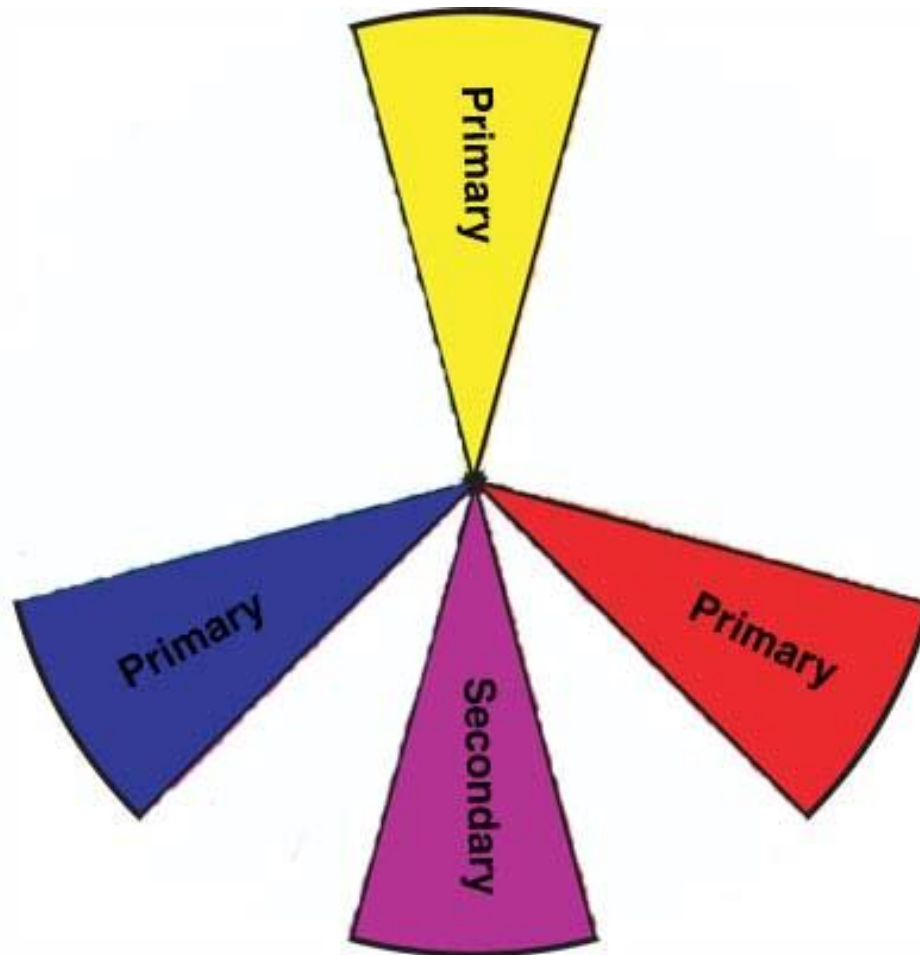


Primary Colours

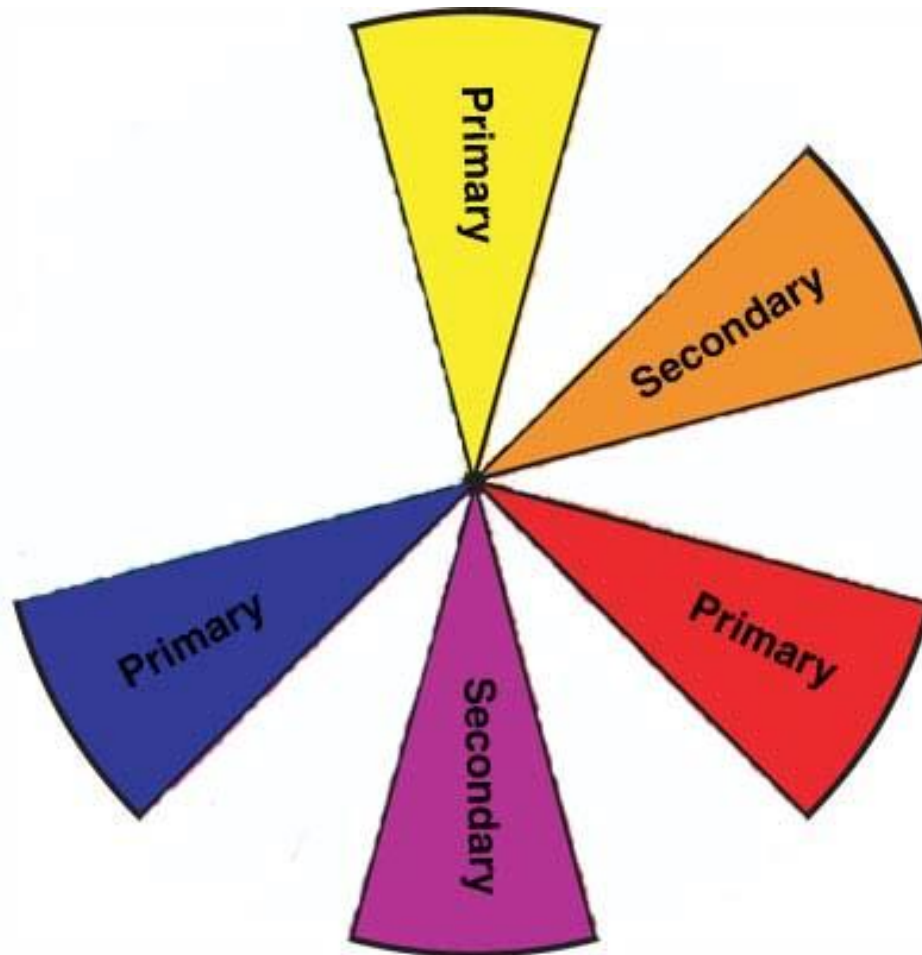


- Cannot be made from any other colours

- Equal distance from each other on colour wheel

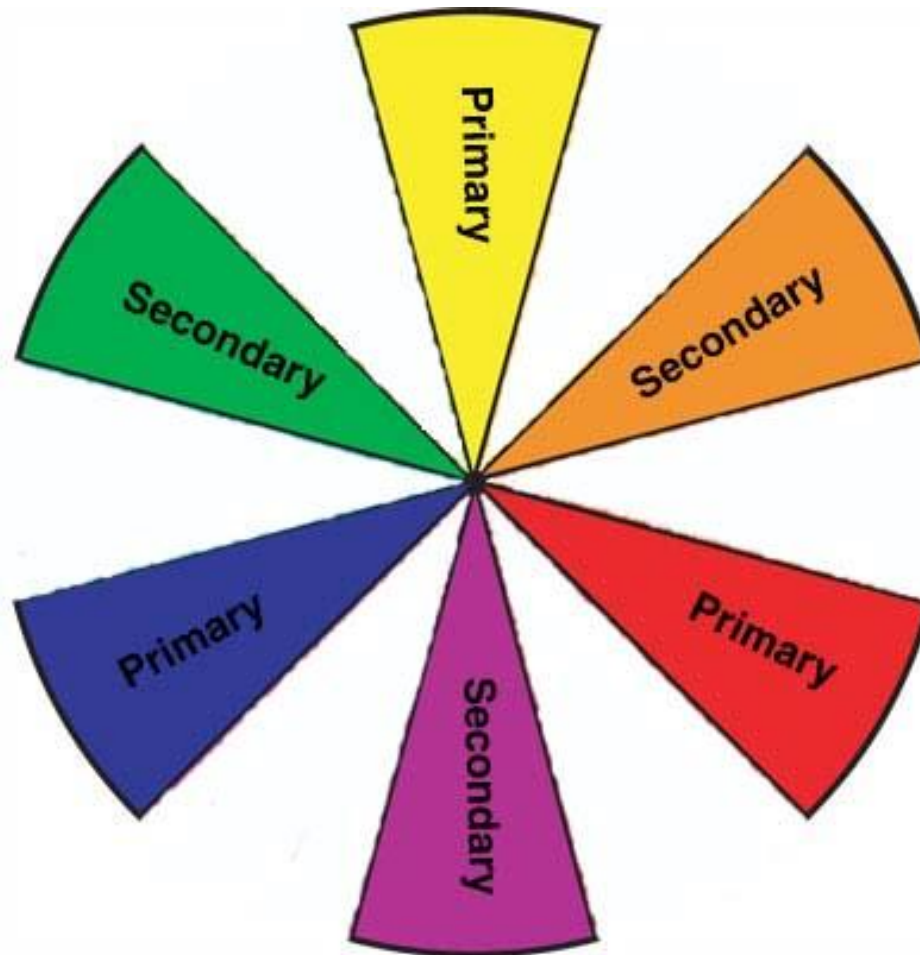
Secondary Colours



Secondary Colours

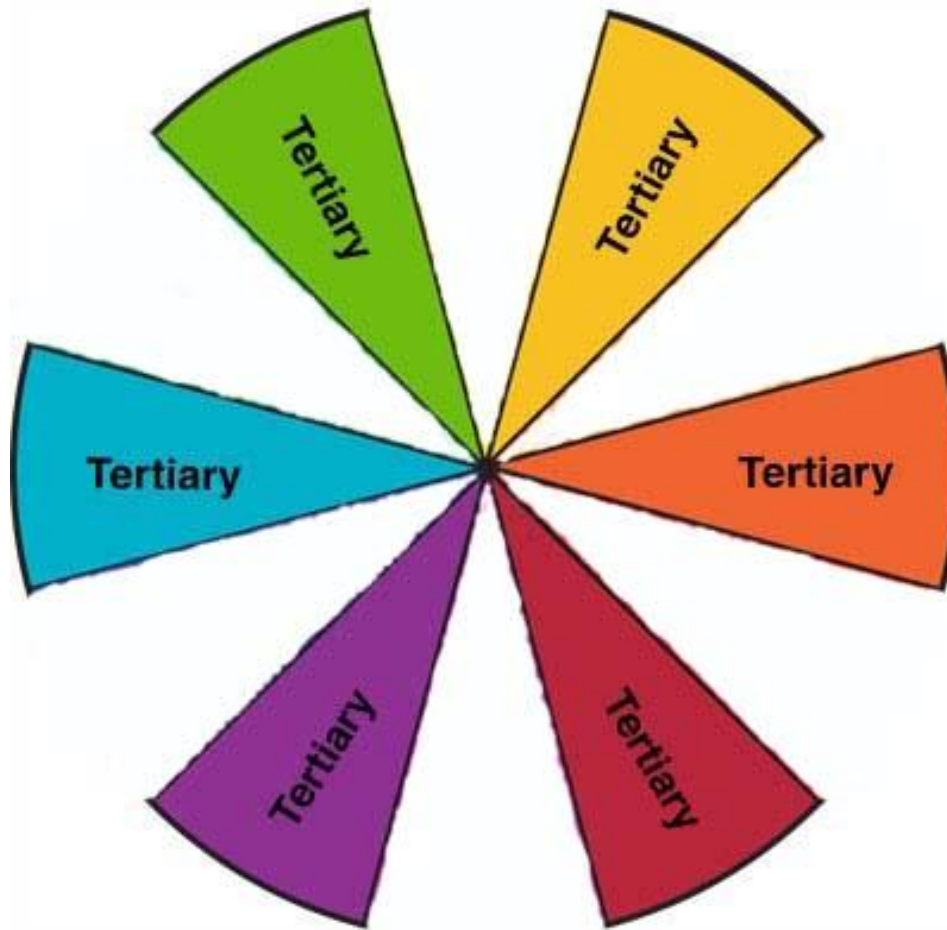


Secondary Colours



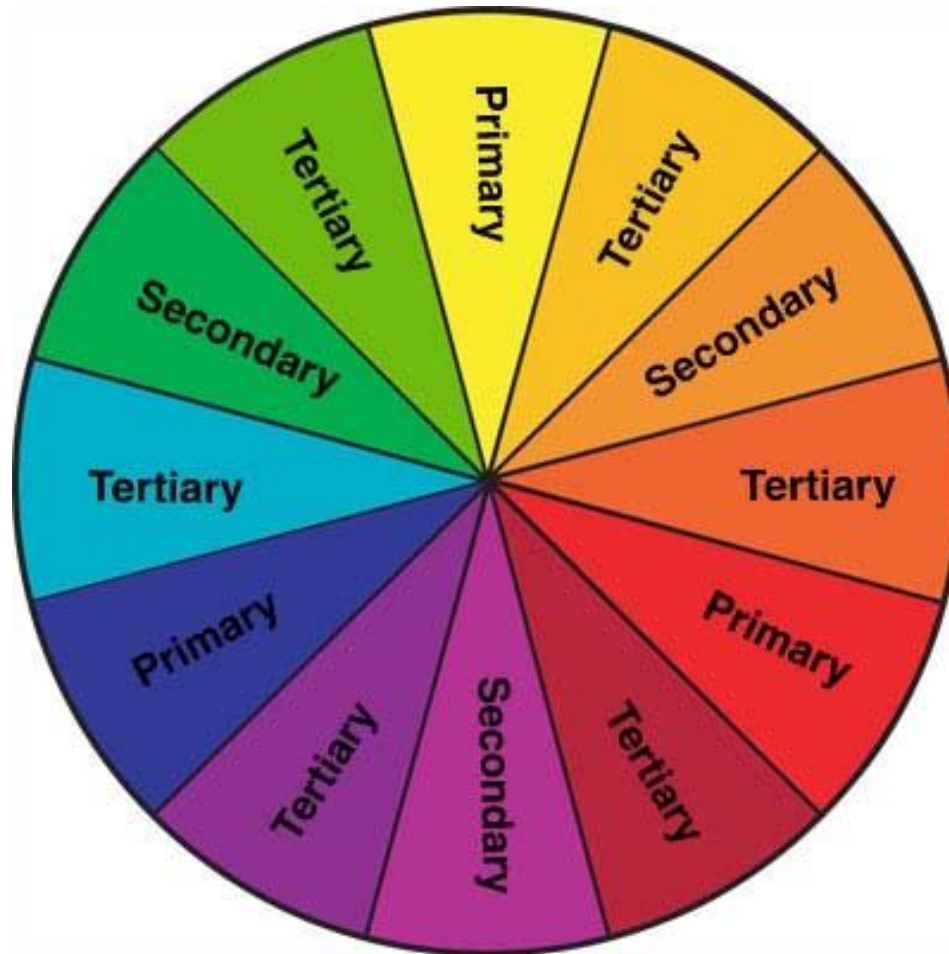
- Made by mixing equal amounts of 2 primary colours
- Found halfway between the primary colours on the wheel

Tertiary Colours

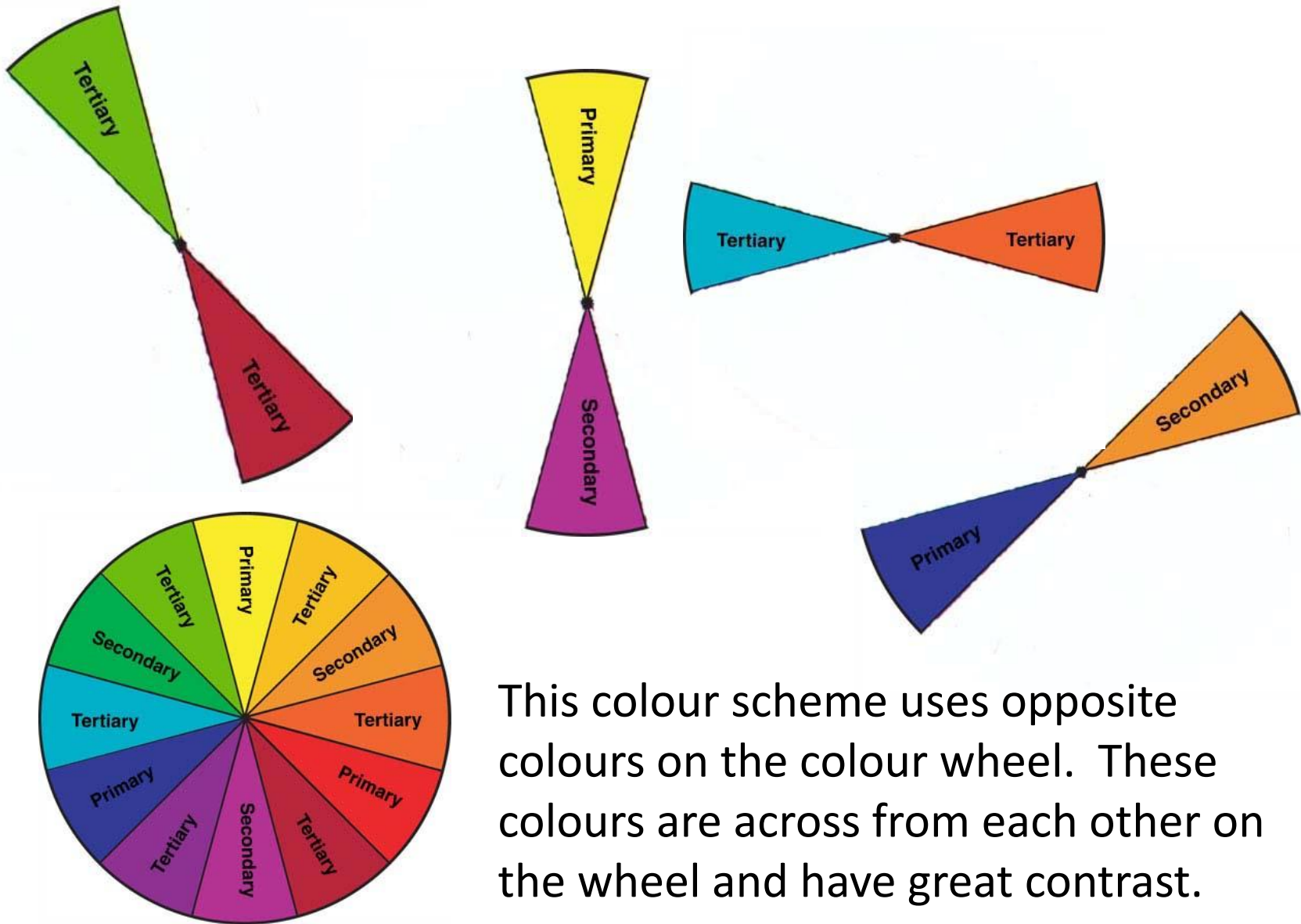


Made by mixing equal amounts of adjoining primary and secondary colours.

Complementary Colours



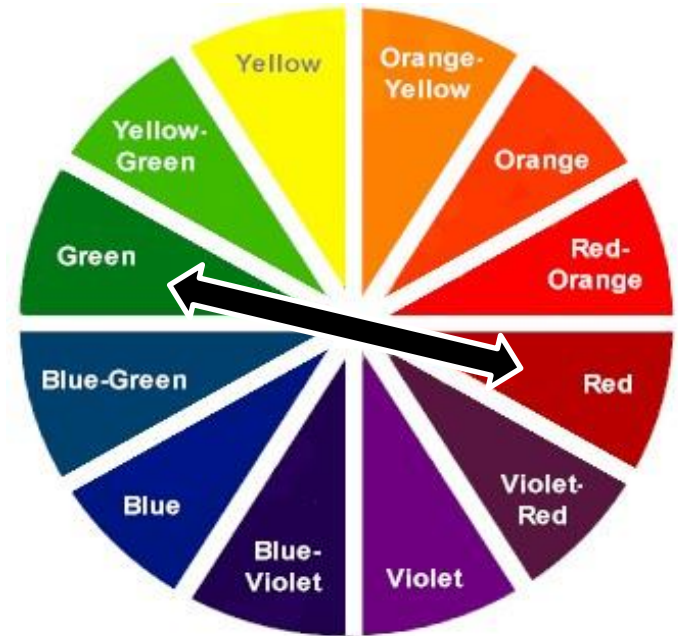
This colour scheme uses opposite colours on the colour wheel. These colours are across from each other on the wheel and have great contrast.

Complementary colours used by Van Gogh



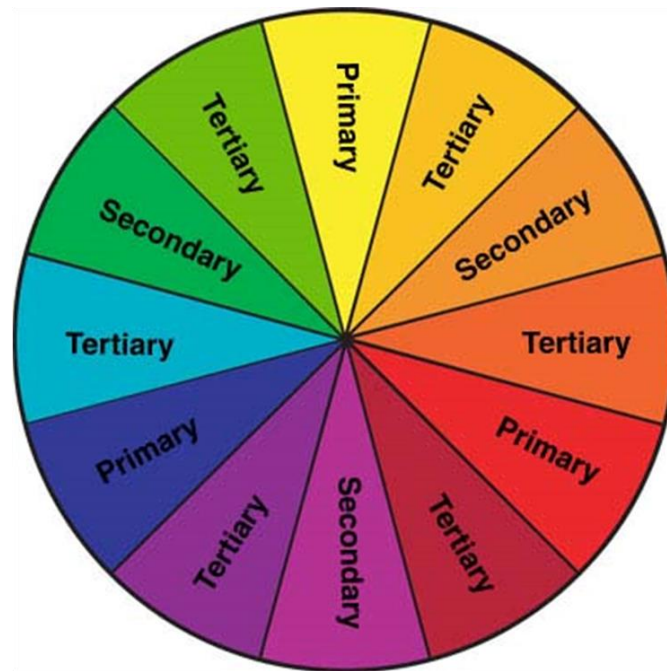
BLUE + ORANGE
