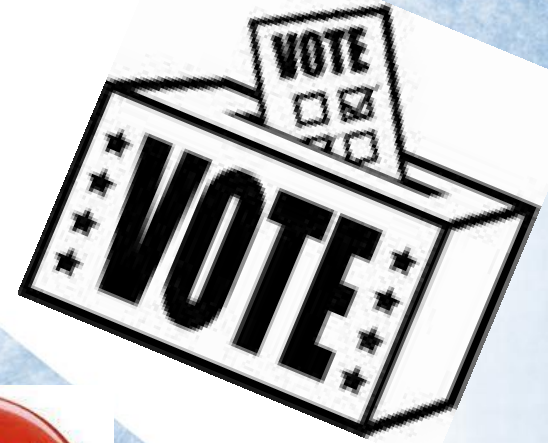

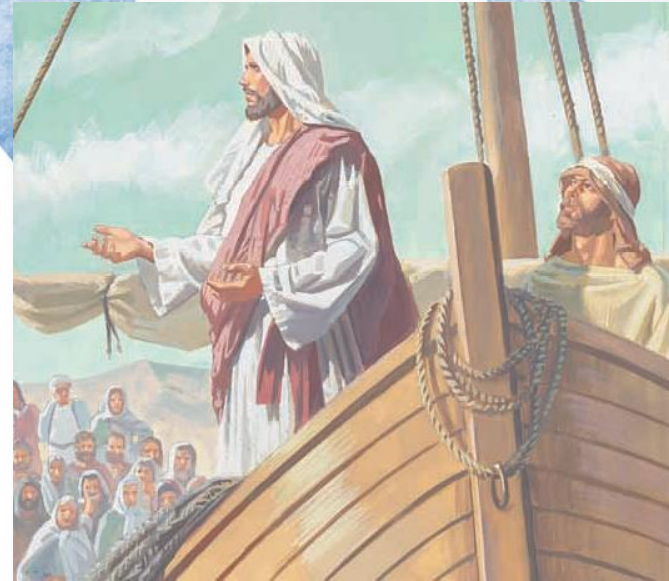
Jesus Chooses His Apostles

After Jesus finished teaching, He told Peter to take the boat into deep water.



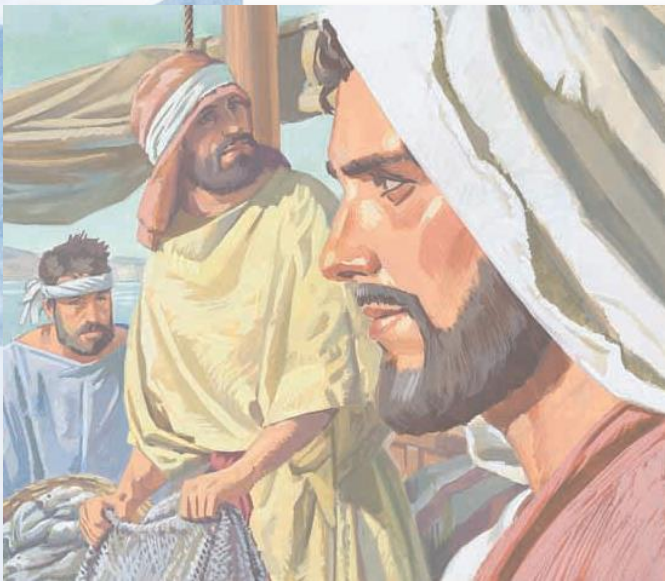
Then He told Peter and his friends to put their fishing nets into the water.

The fish filled both boats so full that they began to sink.





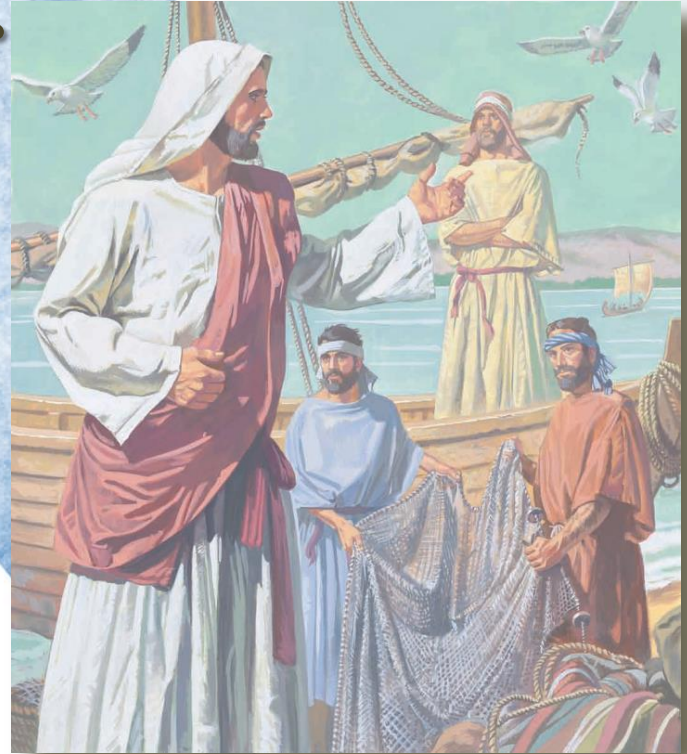
Peter and his friends were amazed. They knew that Jesus Christ had made this happen.

Jesus told Peter, James, and John to follow Him and become "fishers of men."

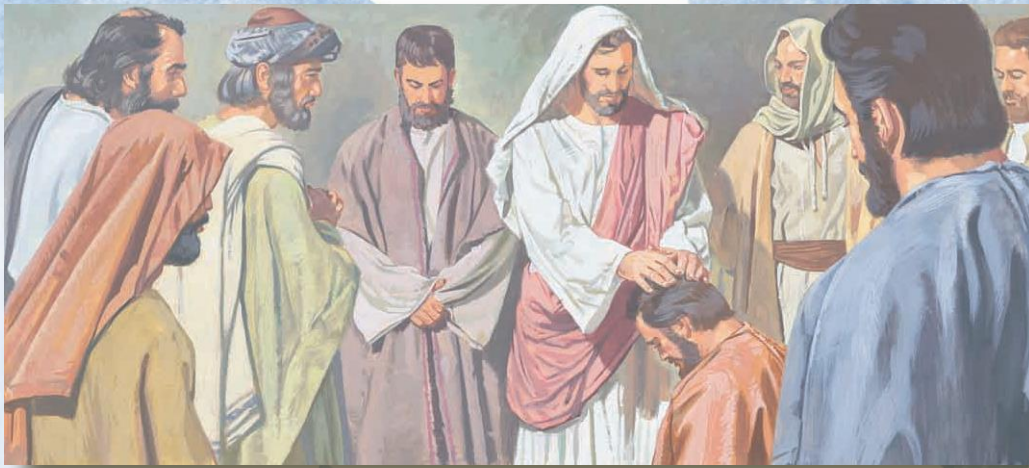


The men left everything they had and went with Jesus.
