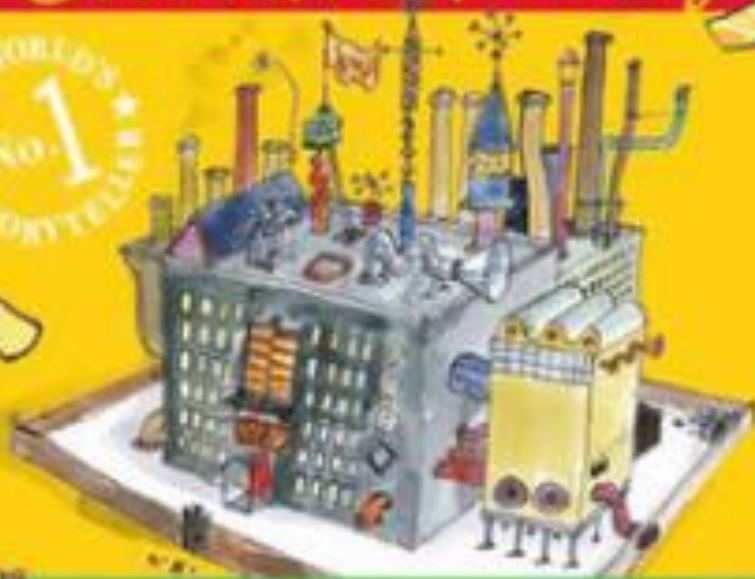

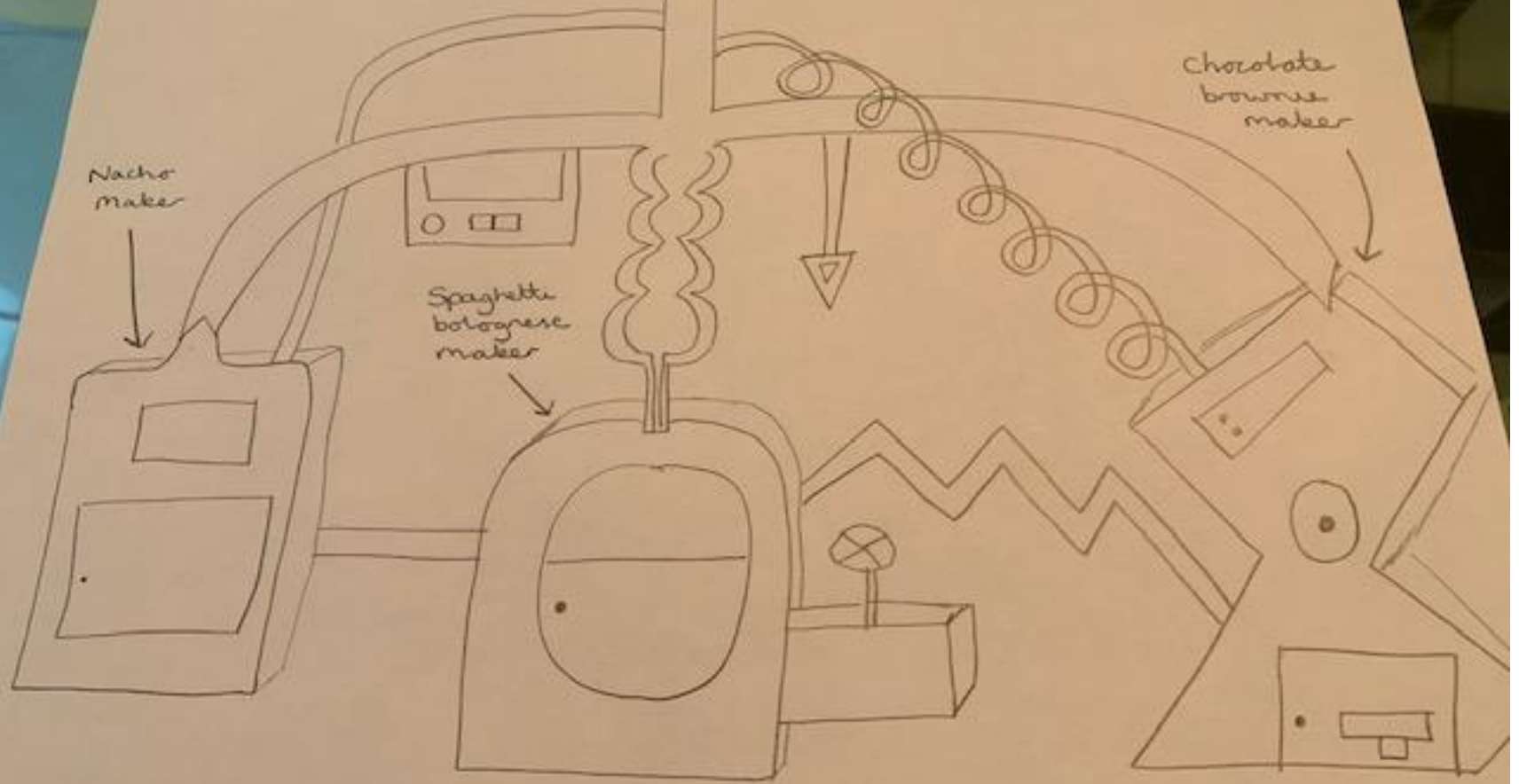

Success Criteria - Instructional Text

- Title Saying what is being explained
- Opening statement (what you are explaining)
- Clear steps numbered steps or time words
e.g. first, then, next, after that
- Step by step instruction so things are done in the right order
- Imperative verbs e.g. pull, push, twist
- Warning (what might go wrong)

Instructions for the Gum Machine

These are the instructions to make a delicious three course meal piece of gum. You must follow each step carefully or disaster may happen!

1. First turn the machine on by pressing the red button on the control panel.
2. Slide the switch to the left for the nachos to drop into the machine.
3. Wait for ten seconds then slide the switch back to drop in the seasoning.
4. Pull three times on the pull cord to release the spaghetti bolognaise.
5. Turn the wheel clockwise to mix the bolognaise sauce and pasta together.
6. Push the double button twice to drop the mixture for the chocolate brownie.
7. Twist the centre dial anticlockwise three complete turns to make your brownie.
8. Knock of the bottom door and out will pop your gum.

Warning do not knock on the door too soon as the gum meal might go horribly wrong!
