The Early Years Foundation Stage

This power point has been prepared for you to share some key information about your child's Nursery experience.

Your child's curriculum has seven areas of learning.

Prime Areas – universal core aspects of early child development

- Communication and Language
- Personal, Social, Emotional Development
- Physical Development

Specific Areas - essential skills and knowledge that are underpinned by the prime areas

- Literacy
- Mathematical Development
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design

In Nursery, there is a strong focus on the Prime areas of Learning as these lay the foundation for children's success in all other areas of learning and life. As children develop and move into Reception, there is a greater focus on the Specific areas of learning to ensure children are ready for school in Year 1.

Supporting learning through sharing stories

Key Texts

In Nursery we share key texts across the year to support our themes and topics. These are displayed on the window by the classroom door. It would be great if you could borrow these from a library or treat your children to one of them for their Birthday or Christmas.



Library Books

Each week we send home a school library book for you to enjoy at home (this will begin in October). You can keep these for up to a week to enjoy with your child. Books are changed by staff when they are placed into the yellow book box.

Bedtime Bag

During the year, the children will all get a chance to have the class Bedtime Bag with a story, cuddly toy, hot chocolate sachet and a biscuit to enjoy with their family at bedtime. Please post the cute pictures onto Tapestry!



Supporting learning through talk activities


Teddy Visits
