

- Monday – Lesson One - You will need paper and a pencil.
- Tuesday – Lesson Two - You will need paper and a pencil.
- Wednesday – Lesson Three - You will need paper and a pencil.
- Thursday – Lesson **Five** – (Just listen to the nursery rhyme) You will paper and a pencil. Helpful tip 1: When you have chosen your setting to draw, relisten to the description from Miss Doherty to help draw the picture. Helpful tip 2: For the example writing, your child will find it easier if you also write the example word out (some of the letters are written as part of a cursive handwriting scheme which we do not follow at school).
- Friday - Lesson **Six** - You will need paper and a pencil. Helpful Tip 1: For the example writing section your child will find it easier if you also write the sentence out (some of the letters are written as part of a cursive handwriting scheme which we do not follow at school). Helpful tip 2: In addition, instead of 'robot the word' use fred fingers to sound out the words. Helpful tip 3: Show the children the sound 'oo' to write room.

Helpful tip: Use pasta, small lego pieces, buttons, broad beans, etc for your counting objects.


- Monday – Lesson One – You will need twenty small objects and the Old Mac Donald’s farmer’s field resource (or draw your own).
- Tuesday – Lesson Two – You will need twenty small objects and the Old Mac Donald’s farmer’s field resource (or draw your own) or 3 different coloured pieces of paper/plates/bowls.
- Wednesday – Lesson Three
- Thursday – Lesson Six - You will need twelve small counting objects, your number cards 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12 and two different coloured pieces of paper/plates/bowls.
- Friday – Lesson Seven - You will need eighteen small counting objects, your number cards 3, 6, 9, 12, 15 and 18 and three different coloured pieces of paper/plates/bowls.

Theme Lessons

Role Play a baptism

Adult Supervision: Can you recreate a Baptism with a doll/teddy bear? Go on a treasure hunt around the house to find the items needed for a Baptism.

Find something white in your house to use as a white garment. Then find a small bowl to hold the water. Make or find a candle to represent the Baptismal candle. Make sure you have enough



teddies/dolls etc to be the people that would be at your Baptism;
