

The Runaway Pancake

Home Learning Challenges

Make some pancakes with a grown-up. Talk to them about the different ways the ingredients are measured. As you mix the ingredients together, look carefully at how the mixture changes. What happens to the mixture when it cooks in the pan? How is it different to the mixture in the bowl?

At the end of The Runaway Pancake story, the pancake was eaten by the pig. Can you think of a different ending for the story? Draw a picture of your new ending. You could even write a sentence to explain what happens.

In the story, the pancake rolls away from everyone who is trying to catch it. Have a look around your house and find some other objects that can roll. Why are these objects able to roll? Why is the pancake able to roll?

Talk to your family and friends about their favourite pancake toppings. Which topping is the most popular? To help you work this out, you could draw a picture of everyone's favourite toppings and then count them. Which topping had the most pictures?

Pancake starts with a 'p' sound. Draw 5 other things that start with 'p'. You could even try to write the name of each object underneath the pictures.

Think about the story of The Runaway Pancake and draw a picture of your favourite character.
