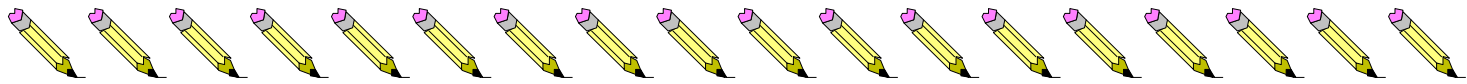
### RE
